



All prize monies are not fixed and are subject to entry numbers and club finances during 2022

Entry Fees of \$5.00 per player will be matched on a Dollar-for-Dollar basis by the Club.

Prize money will be paid to the Winner/s and Runner/s Up only.

Payment will be distributed on an approximate ratio of 2:1

1.1 Snooker - Scratch Doubles Championship

(February - March: Nominations January 2022)

- > This tournament is the best of three frames straight knockout with best of 5 frames final
- > Prize money dependant on number of entries, tournament is self funded (See above).

1.2 Snooker - Handicap Doubles Championships

(February - March: Nominations January 2022)

- > This tournament is the best of three frames straight knockout with best of 5 frames final
- > The lower handicapped team is to start on zero
- > Team pairs will be randomly drawn. This is not a select your own partner competition
- > Prize money dependant on number of entries, tournament is self funded (See above).

2 Snooker - Open (A), B and C Grade Scratch Championships

(April, May & June: nominations March 2022)

- > A Grade is a best of five frames straight knockout with best of 7 frames final
- > B Grade is a best of three frames straight knockout with best of 5 frames final
- > C grade is a best of three frames straight knockout for all matches
- > **C Grade players may also play in A and B Grade**
- > **B grade players may also play in A Grade**
- > Prize money dependant on number of entries, tournament is self funded (See above).

3.1 Billiards - Scratch Championship

(July - August: nominations June 2022)

- > This tournament is the first to 150 with the final first to 300
- > Prize money dependant on number of entries, tournament is self funded (See above).

3.2 Billiards - Handicap Championship

(July - August: nominations June 2022)

- > This tournament is the first to 150 points with the lower handicap player starting from zero
- > The final is also to 150 points with the lower handicap player starting from zero
- > If a player has a negative handicap ,they must score this amount before starting from zero
- > Prize money dependant on number of entries, tournament is self funded (See above).

4 Snooker - Handicap Championship

(September - October: Nominations August 2022)

- > This tournament is a best of three frames straight knockout with best of 5 frames final
- > The lower handicapped player is to start on zero
- > Prize money dependant on number of entries, tournament is self funded (See above).
