This competition is a single frame handicap knockout with the draw made out of a hat. First round losers go into a consolation draw.

One competitor (members only), drawn at random, is declared the "Jackpot Player" and will receive the "Jackpot" cash prize if that person wins the main draw.

If someone knocks out the Jackpot Player, that person is rewarded with \$5.00 voucher and and the jackpot amount increases by \$2 for the following week.

Prizes are awarded to Winner and Runner-up of each draw.
