ANNUAL REPORT 2024

Thankfully we have well passed the years of tight restrictions and numbers using the facilities of the Club has grown. Our membership numbers in 2023 reached 56 financial members. This is the first year when our membership has reverted to the usual annual membership.

In 2023 we had grown our bank balance notwithstanding the restrictions during the COVID years and committee decided to make a one off gift to the members of having the presentation dinner fully funded by the committee.

The committee doubts this can become annual so we expect there to be a charge on members for 2024 presentation dinner.

COVID

Whilst we are out of the period of restrictions we are aware this virus is still active in this area but no longer impacting our operations.

Tuesday Jackpot level

In 2023 there have been three jackpot winners including the last of the SUPER jackpot winners. The committee has decided NOT to accept any future offers aimed at providing another SUPER jackpot. Instead committee has increased the accumulation rate for the jackpot and the restart amount after it is won.

Interclub Competitions

Over 2023 Woolgoolga lost its tables and we are considering whether future play with that group of players is possible.

Committee shall reconsider opening other areas of interclub play now COVID is less of a concern of course with the concurrence of the RSL club

Our Financial Position

In 2022 and 2023 we regained the income from the Panthers football club through us manning the gate for home games now in the form of an agreed amount per home game. That is by an agreement each year with the Panthers football club. Thanks to the team who undertake that work.

Thanks are due to Bernie Couzens for his stewardship of our finances

Annual Opening balances are -1/1/2021 \$4497.93; 1/1/2022 \$4122.03; 31/12/22 \$2969.45; 31/12/2023 \$956.73

During the year our balance reached a peak of \$ 7108.63 which led the committee to make the one off gift of a free presentation dinner to all members attending.

2020 to 2021 income to each monthly comp determined the prizes, but in 2022 that was doubled from club funds. In 2023 those competitions where there is income from players had their prizes doubled from club funds. The incoming committee shall need to reconsider this as our bank balance recovers from the cost for the presentation dinner.

This may require some fundraising effort from members this year to keep us in balance for the future.

Committee Membership

Recently committee has lost two members (one of whom moved interstate, and the other was unable to continue due to work pressures) and this election year shall fill both vacancies
