

## **Structure**

This competition is a single frame handicap knockout. First round losers go into a consolation draw.

One competitor (members only), drawn at random, is declared the "Jackpot Player" and will receive the "Jackpot" cash prize if that person wins the main draw.

If someone knocks out the Jackpot Player, that person is rewarded with \$5.00 and the jackpot amount increases by \$5.00 for the following week.

Prizes are awarded to Winner and Runner-up of each draw.

Entry fee \$5.00 for members and \$7.00 for visitors.

## **Handicapping**

A list of handicaps for each player for a 15 red frame is maintained, handicaps are adjusted depending on reds played.

The minimum handicap is -50

The maximum handicap in general is +70

The maximum start for a single 10 red frame is 50, for 6 reds it is 30.

Handicaps may be varied at the discretion of the committee.
